Dr. Edmund J. Malesky is a Professor of Political Science at Duke University, Director of the Duke Center for International Development, and Chair of the Executive Council of Southeast Asian Research Group (SEAREG). He has been the lead researcher of USAID's Vietnam Provincial Competitiveness Index project since 2005, for which he was awarded a state medal in 2014. His research focuses on the political economy of development, governance, and authoritarian institutions. He has published two books, including Incentives to Pander: How Politicians Use Corporate Welfare for Political Gain and China's Governance Puzzle: Enabling Transparency and Participation in an Authoritarian State.
