Ms. Murray writes PIRG's annual "Trouble in Toyland" reports which monitors safety issues and risks in children's products. She joined PIRG four years ago after a career as a newspaper reporter, most recently covering consumer issues and personal finance for two decades for Ohio's largest daily newspaper.
