Emily de La Bruyère is a co-founder of Horizon Advisory, a leading geopolitical and supply chain intelligence provider. She holds a BA *summa cum laude* from Princeton University and a *summa cum laude* MA from Sciences Po, Paris. She has testified on technology, industrial, and influence risks posed by China before the Senate Banking Committee, the US-China Economic Security and Review Commission, and the House Select Committee on China. Her commentaries on strategic competition with the Chinese Communist Party have been published in outlets ranging from Bloomberg to TechCrunch, and her work on supply chain risks has been profiled in outlets ranging from the *New York Times* and the *Wall Street Journal* to *The Economist* and the *Washington Post*. Emily holds affiliations with think tanks focused on national security and competition with China, including as a Senior Fellow at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies, a Senior Visiting Fellow at the Krach Institute for Tech Diplomacy at Purdue, and a non-resident fellow at the National Bureau of Asian research.
