Mr. Dave Cavossa is President of the Commercial Space Federation (CSF). Cavossa is a long-time space and satellite industry executive working at the intersection of commercial space, government affairs, and government services.

Throughout his more than 20 years in the space and satellite sectors, Cavossa has held various government affairs and P&L leadership roles. He served various roles at the Satellite Industry Association, including six years as Executive Director and Chairman of the Board. He then served in executive roles with multiple satellite and defense contractors including Harris Corporation, CapRock Government Solutions, and Arrowhead Global Solutions. Mr. Cavossa began his career in 2001 at NASA Headquarters in D.C., as an intern, working in the Legislative Affairs and International Relations offices. He was a Space Policy Fellow and holds an M.A. Degree from George Washington University in D.C., and a B.A. Degree in Physics, Astronomy, and Political Science from Wheaton College in Massachusetts.
