John Costello a New America Cybersecurity Policy Fellow and the Executive Director of the China Cyber and Intelligence Studies Institute, a non-profit seeking to study China's use of cyber and information as instruments of national power. Previously Mr. Costello was a Senior Analyst for Flashpoint and a Congressional Innovation Fellow with the Republican staff of the House Oversight and Government Reform IT Subcommittee. Mr. Costello was an analyst at Defense Group Inc's, Center for Intelligence Research and Analysis. While a member of the U.S. Navy and intelligence community, Mr. Costello established himself as a leading thinker in Chinese cyber warfare, emerging technologies, and information warfare. He holds a B.A. from University of Maryland University College and graduated with honors from the Defense Language Institute and is fluent in Chinese Mandarin. He most recently co-authored a chapter on Chinese information warfare in the edited volume *China's Evolving Military Strategy*. Mr. Costello previously testified before the Commission in 2017 and 2016.

Mr. Costello previously testified before the Commission in 2016 on Chinese intelligence services and in 2017 on China's efforts in quantum information science.
