Jeff M. Smith is the Director of Asian Security Programs and the Kraemer Strategy Fellow. He is the author of *Cold Peace: Sino-Indian Rivalry in the 21st Century* (Lexington Books, 2014), Co-Editor of the *World Almanac of Islamism 2014* (Rowman and Littlefield 2014), and contributing author to a number of books and monographs on Asian security issues.

Smith has served in an advisory role for multiple presidential campaigns and has testified as an expert witness before the House Armed Services and Foreign Affairs Committees. He provides regular briefings for Members of Congress and their staff on Capitol Hill, as well as officials in the State Department, Pentagon, and intelligence community. His writings on Asian security issues have appeared in *Foreign Affairs*, the *Wall Street Journal, Foreign Policy*, CNN, the *Harvard International Review, Jane's Intelligence Review, Defense News*, and *The Diplomat*, among others.

Smith is a regular traveler to Asia and has participated in a dozen senior delegations to Asian countries and hosted several dozen visiting experts and foreign delegations here in Washington DC. In the media, his interviews and commentary has been featured in *The Economist*, the BBC, CNN, Fox News, CBS, CNBC, the Voice of America, TIME Magazine, and Agence France-Presse. Smith has an MPIA in Security and Intelligence Studies from the GSPIA at the University of Pittsburgh. He studied abroad at Oxford University in 2005 and has guest-lectured at the graduate and undergraduate level.
