

Mr. Paul Hubbard, Sir Roland Wilson Ph.D. Scholar, Australian National University

Mr. Hubbard is a Ph.D. candidate in economics in the Crawford School of Public Policy at the Australian National University. His research focuses on reform and governance of Chinese stateowned enterprises. In 2015, he was a visiting scholar at Peking University's National School of Development. He is on leave from the Australian Treasury, where he has served in various roles since 2006.

He has recently published several East Asian Bureau of Economic Research working papers related to state-owned enterprise monopolies, discrepancies between national- and local-level state-owned enterprises, and capital efficiency.

Mr. Hubbard earned a graduate degree in economics from the Australian National University and a dual B.A. in Chinese language and law from the University of Tasmania. He was previously a Fulbright scholar at the Maxwell School of Syracuse University, and also studied at Tsinghua University in Beijing.
